The Department of Biological Sciences invites applications from academically qualified and professionally experienced individuals for a 12-month, non-tenure track position as Human Anatomy Instructor. Candidates are expected to have a Ph.D. in the biological sciences and be dedicated to providing an enriching learning experience in Human Anatomy and Human Anatomy laboratory. Willingness to teach active learning courses is required and experience in active learning classes is preferred. The Department of Biological Sciences is committed to developing novel learning activities that will prepare students for success in a fast-paced global environment. Human Anatomy is a high enrollment undergraduate course. Teaching of other undergraduate upper and lower division courses may also be expected, depending on specialization and departmental needs. The Biological Sciences Department has 4800+ undergraduate majors, ~120 graduate students, and 58 faculty members on two large campuses (<http://www.fiu.edu/about-us/campuses/index.html>), one in west Miami (MMC), and one on Biscayne Bay (BBC).
